Tampere regional transport has three buses driving the Night of the Museums-line - marked with a orange line on the map - from 6pm to 11.30pm. The first bus starts from the Museum Centre Vapriikki at 6pm, departures approximately every 10 minutes. With the Night of the Museums entrance wristband you can travel by the bus between our attractions.

With the bus 40B you can get to the Automobile and road museum Mobilia in Kangasala by showing your entrance wristband. Buses 2, 6, 9, 15, 40A and 40B take you to the Moomin museum.

If need be, inform the driver and the buses will also stop on the regular bus stops on the route.
